 - i. Each member must do at least 3 Scrimmage games; failure to do so we be a \$30 fine

- i. No longer give an Indirect Free Kick to a team in clear possession of the ball if there is a temporary suspension of play for an injury or unusual situation and play is stopped. Restart is now a dropped ball and can be contested by any number of players, including goalkeepers.
Note: Only if goalkeeper is in possession, it will be IDF.
 - ii. In high school, ball has to completely leave Penalty Area on a Goal Kick in order for the ball to be in play.
Note: This includes ANY restart to the defending team, originating from the Penalty Area, not just goal kicks. If the ball doesn't leave the Penalty Area on the initial touch, retake the Goal Kick or Free Kick.
 - iii. Stop the clock during the last 5 minutes of the second half or overtime half **ONLY** if the team in the lead substitutes.
